



St. Vivian School FOOD SERVICE

Saint Vivian School shall operate a school lunchroom for the benefit of students and employees.

The food-service program shall comply with federal, state and local regulations pertaining to the selection, preparation, consumption and disposal of food and beverages as well as to the fiscal management of the program.

Lunches sold by the school may be purchased by the students and staff members.

The operation and supervision of the food-service program shall be the responsibility of the Food Services Department in accordance with federal law.

No food or beverages, other than those associated with the schools food service program, are to be sold before the school day, during school hours or for 30 minutes after the end of the school day. The Food Service department shall serve only nutritious food as determined by the United States Department of Agriculture and Ohio Department of Education as outlined in the Wellness Policy.

All foods offered for sale during the school day by Food Services will comply with the Wellness Policy and the Nutritional Standards as dictated by the United States Department of Agriculture's SMART SNACK regulation.

Before any snacks are sold to students they are verified to be in compliance. The Alliance For A Healthier Generation web-site will be used for this verification.

Drinks sold a la carte will include 8oz. fat free milk containing no more than 150 calories. 100% juice will be available with a 6.75 oz. serving with less than 160 calories. Non-flavored water will also be sold. Drinking water and cups are available free of charge and are located at the fountain.

Food Services will not purchase with food service funds and shall not serve, in any food service area during meal-serving hours, added caffeine beverages, water ices, chewing gum, hard candy(including breath mints and cough drops), jellies and gums, marshmallow candies, fondant(creamy sugar candy), licorice, spun candy and candy-coated popcorn.
