



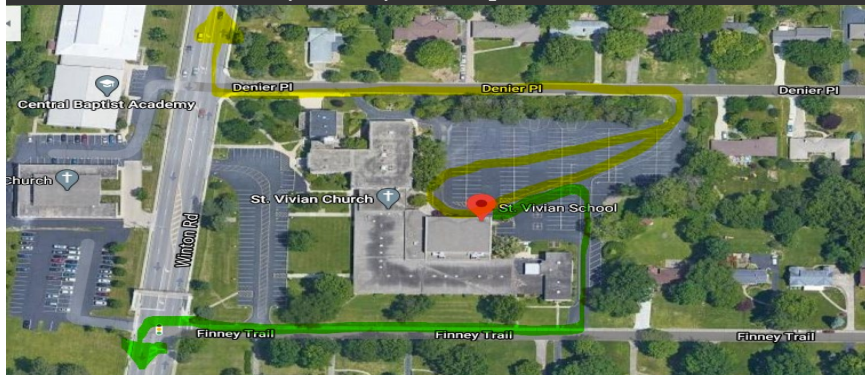

## Re-Enrollment for 2021-22 School Year

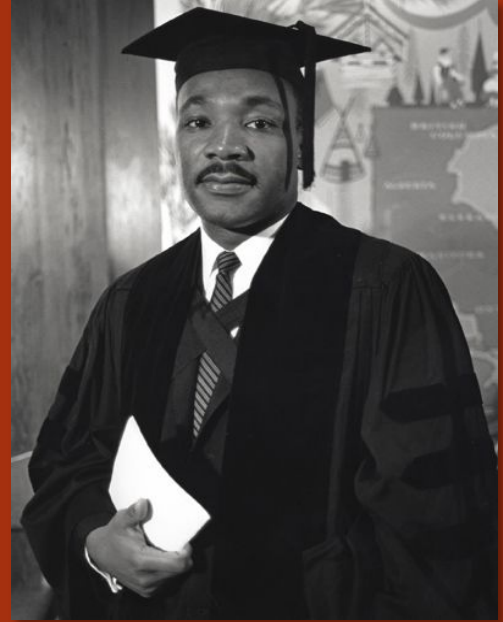
### Items and dates of importance:

1. Only one re-enrollment form per family is needed, along with the \$175 registration fee.
2. The deadline for re-enrollment is Friday, January 29, 2021 at 2:20 pm.
3. Please list Kindergarten (or any new students you plan on attending school next year) on the form or online: [www.mystvivian.org](http://www.mystvivian.org).
4. Tuition rates have not been set for the 2021-2022 school year, but a slight increase should be expected.

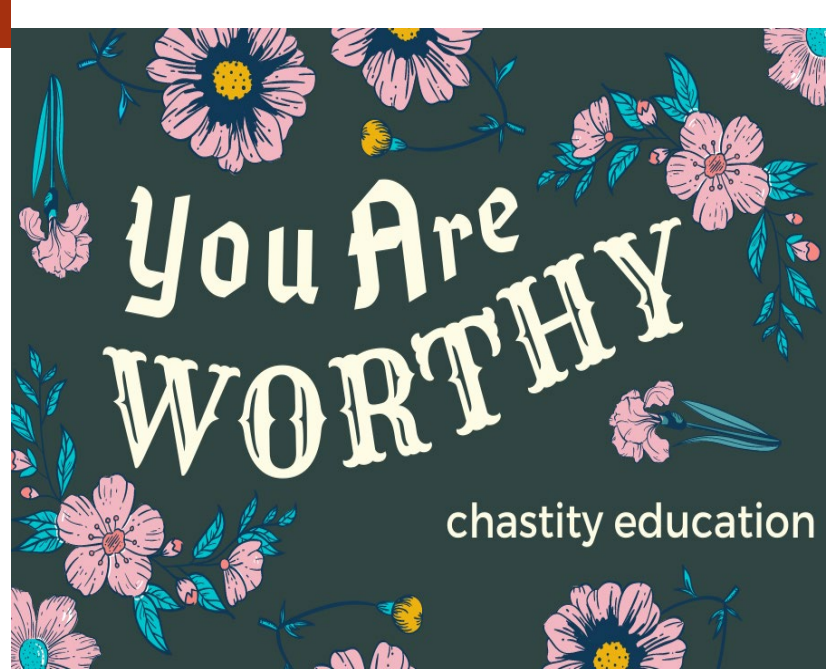
### *What Emily Teaches:*

Identity. Love. Chastity. The world is a difficult place for teens, and it has become increasingly hard for parents and educators to help teens discover the truth about their bodies, their sexuality, and their unique call to love.

The Chastity Education Program at Pregnancy Center East teaches the beauty and truth of St. John Paul II’s Theology of the Body, in a way that gives students practical and real-life applications. We examine topics of authentic relationships, dating, human dignity, and the gift of human sexuality through the lens of the virtue of Chastity.

Our curriculum is designed to share these important messages with students according to the unique developmental needs of every grade level in which we present.

### *KEY CONCEPTS FOR IN CONTROL:*

- Curriculum is 100% in accordance with the Catechism of the Catholic Church
- Virtue is a habit and attitude to do the good
- Chastity is a virtue and is God’s plan for our sexuality
- Chastity has six key principles:
  1. Modesty
  2. Purity in thoughts, words & actions
  3. Respect yourself and others
  4. Save sexual activity for marriage
  5. Faithfulness to spouse
  6. Priests/Religious take a vow of celibacy
- Love is doing what is best for the other person

### 4<sup>th</sup> GRADE JANUARY SERVICE: OUR DAILY BREAD BAG LUNCH PROGRAM

Grade 4 participated in their service project today. They learned about homelessness, hunger, food deserts and food insecurity in our own county. April Hoak from Catholic Charities helped with both our learning and our service! Our students made turkey and cheese sandwiches, and included fruit and chips in lunch bags that they decorated with kind messages. These wonderful kids packed 210 lunches this morning! Thank you grace 4!

We had more donations than ever before (\$505!!), so Mrs. Zeinner's 8th grade class packed 115 more this afternoon- 325 people fed in total! We surpassed our goal of making 200 lunches AND were able to also add chips and fruit!
