

2021 Boys and Girls Golf

St. Bart's (SBAA) along with St. Vivian is offering Boys and Girls Golf for the Summer/Fall 2021. This will be for athletes from $5^{th} - 8^{th}$ grade (entering the 2021-22 school year). Cost - \$110 which will include

green fees and a uniform shirt/hat. **Online registration is open from** <u>March 1st through March 14th</u> and can be found at: <u>www.stbartsathletics.org</u> You can complete multiple registrations during one transaction. Credit/Debit transactions only. Tryouts are in May at Robins Nest (Date TBD). Unexperienced golfers will play 2-3 rounds. More experienced golfers may need to play 3-4 rounds. Season starts in July and finishes in Late August – roughly 10-12 matches. Most play will occur at Robins Nest / Meadow Links / Fairfield Greens. Many of the matches will be during the weekday (starting as early as 9:00am). Volunteers will be needed to walk with the kids during a match – grandparents welcomed! There will NOT be cuts for golf. All kids will play in matches throughout the season. Both Boys and girls will play in the same match – this is a co-ed league and play is determined by score. \$1,000 Linda Dodd Memorial Fund Scholarship Available for the 2021-22 School Year!

Students not receiving Ohio State Vouchers may apply for a scholarship by submitting an essay answering "Why is reading important to me?" Three scholarships will be awarded with one in each of the following category:

- o Kindergarten through Grade 2
- Grade 3 through Grade 5
- Grade 6 through Grade 7

The application process will begin on April 15th and be open until April 30th.

For the 2021-22 school year, the scholarship amount to be awarded is \$1,000. Scholarship awards are non-transferrable if the student leaves St. Vivian, and only applicable for the upcoming school year. No actual funds will be given to the families, but applied to the family's tuition balance. All essays are blindly reviewed (child's name and identifying information is removed) and winners are chosen by the Tuition Review Board.



Linda Dodd was a beloved teacher at St. Vivian for 20 years. She tragically died in an automobile accident in 2000. A memorial fund was started and a memorial garden was developed outside the school library to commemorate Linda's love of reading. Her family developed the "Human Fund" in her honor and hold an annual golf outing to raise funds for Catholic education at St. Vivian and several area Catholic high schools.



REMINDERS & NEWS:

Please pay all fees! The end of the

year is fast approaching and it is time to make sure EVERYTHING is current in your family's accounts. This is tuition, lunch fees, and returned library books. As a reminder, it is stated in our handbook policies that if fees are unpaid, your 8th grade child will not gradute. For returning students, final report cards will not be given and fees will be deducted from next year's registration - moving your child out of registered YOU COULD status. This means BE UNENROLLED AND LOSE YOUR SLOT FOR NEXT YEAR!



Lunch fees: An email will be sent to each

individual family with the outstanding amount the student owes by the end of next week. If the amount is over \$25, starting Monday 4/19, your child will not be allowed to order a second helping or extra (a la carte) milk.

Virtus Training Change:

ALL PARISH/SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS: NEW CHILD PROTECTION PLATFORM

In July 2021 the archdiocese will be moving to **SafeParish** as the new platform for Child Protection training and compliance. SafeParish is an organization that specializes in training and education solutions for organizations worldwide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider – Selection.com.

- All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish.
- NO new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS.
- Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees and will consist of QUARTERLY interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins.

As the archdiocese moves closer to the conversion date, additional information regarding your new SafeParish account will be provided.
