- 2 ¹/₂ cups chicken broth
- 1 (15 ounce) can pumpkin puree
- ½ onion, chopped
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1 teaspoon Cajun seasoning
- ¹/₂ cup heavy cream

Directions:

- Heat chicken broth, pumpkin puree, onion, garlic, and Cajun seasoning to a boil in a saucepan over medium-high heat.
- Reduce heat to low and simmer for 45 to 60 minutes, stirring every 15 minutes.
- 3. Stir in heavy cream before serving.

 - View required videos of the necessary topics for working with children
 - Complete the video assessment to ensure your understanding of the topic covered
- STAY CURRENT with email assessments from SafeParish; if you miss just one, you WON'T be able to volunteer until you are current again.
