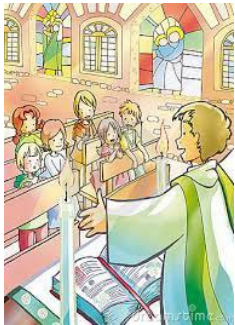
High School Placement Test for 8th Grade

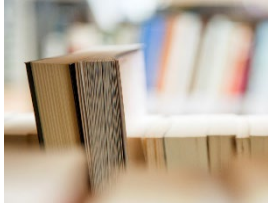
First School Mass

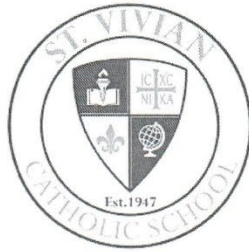
