



Morning Care Location Change

As of Monday, September 26, morning care moved back to the **cafeteria**. (It had been located there pre-COVID.) Students who will be dropped off for morning care by car between 7:00 and 7:25 may be dropped off at the circle drive doors (off of Denier Place), or parents may pull up to the back doors and let students hop out. Please have students ready to exit the car when you pull up to the doors so that other cars aren't backed up behind you.

It is recommended that you drop off your kids early to avoid any back up. Students dropped off in the back may walk through the breezeway and go out the main doors to the side door of the cafeteria. Students who ride a bus will enter through the side door in the morning, which is to the left of the main doors. Cars should not pull into the front of the building as the buses will be dropping off students there.



Progress Reports

St. Vivian operates on trimesters. Each trimester is 12 weeks long. Halfway between each trimester we will issue progress reports to indicate how your child(ren) is doing so far in the trimester. This is NOT a report card. It is a “check-in” so you know if your child(ren) needs to improve in any subjects or areas before report cards are issued. It can also serve as discussion points for parent-teacher conferences. Paper copies were sent home today for parent/caregiver signature. Grades can be found in Option C any time you want to check. All families automatically are enrolled in Option C. To access your account, your user name is your email address. Mrs. Valero in the school office can help with passwords for log in. Progress reports should be checked and then signed by parents/caregivers. Students should return the signed progress reports to their homeroom teachers on Monday, October 3.

GIRLS 3rd-8th BASKETBALL SEASON INFORMATION

Based on a recent league vote, there will be some changes for the 2022-2023 girls basketball season. Due to declining numbers, the GCCYS wants to be proactive and provide fewer obstacles for girls who want to play basketball but also play another sport. The hope is that these changes result in increased numbers for girls' basketball.

Here are the changes for the upcoming season:

1. The girls' season will begin the first weekend in November and will take place on the following weekends: 11/5, 11/12, 11/19, 12/3 (boys start at this time), 12/10, 12/17, 1/7
2. The girls' tournament will take place from January 12-15
3. Instead of separate 5th and 6th grade divisions, there will now be a combined 5th/6th grade division and will be referred to as the "reserve" division. Levels of play offered will be level 1, level 2, level 3, and level 5 (recreational). Parishes/schools can choose how they want to build the combined grade teams, but they need to register them in the appropriate skill level.
4. Instead of separate 7th and 8th grade divisions, there will now be a combined 7th/8th grade division and will be referred to as the "varsity" division. Levels of play offered will be level 1, level 2, level 3, and level 5 (recreational). Parishes/schools can choose how they want to build the combined grade teams, but they need to register them in the appropriate skill level.
