Catholic schools were recognized for their progress amid the pandemic. The article, "Amid the Pandemic, Progress in Catholic Schools" by Kathleen Porter-Magee, reported that the average score of 4th graders in Catholic schools was 17 points higher than public schools. In 8th grade, Catholic school students were about 20 points higher in reading than their public-school counterparts. The article noted that disaggregated data for race showed significant gains for black and Hispanic students enrolled in Catholic schools. Black students increased their scores by 10 points and Hispanic students increased their scores by 7 points. The information comes from the Nation's Report Card published by the National Assessment of Educational Progress.



Chaperones for Field Trips and Classroom Celebrations

As classes begin to schedule field trips and other events, please remember that only those adults that are Safe Parish trained and compliant may attend or chaperone an event with children.

Every person in a position which requires contact or interaction with youth or vulnerable adults must complete the **SafeParish™** edition of Protecting Children from Sexual Abuse training session before they are permitted to work or volunteer within any of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati parishes, schools, or institutions. No one under the age of 18 is permitted to complete the training.

In addition to completing the training, employees and volunteers must stay current in completing their interactive video-based **SafeParish™** quarterly bulletins on Child Protection in order to remain in compliance with the requirements of the Decree on Child Protection. Non-compliance will result in **SafeParish™** account non-approval and <u>non-compliant employees and volunteers will no longer be permitted to work with youth or vulnerable adults until compliance is reestablished</u>.
