PTA January Meeting

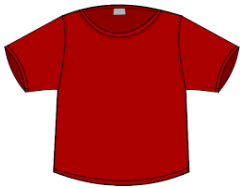
The January PTA meeting will be Thursday, January 12 at 7:00 in Ursuline Hall. All are welcome to attend!
