Medication of ANY Kind – Prescription or Over-the- Counter – Policy

As a reminder, do not send any medication – even over the counter medication – with students to school. We know that students get ill, but students can't have medication at school without a doctor's note and the medication must be in original packaging. ALL medication must go through the nurse or office at all times. Students can't carry around medication as it creates the potential for another student to get a hold of it.

While one child may not have any negative effects taking a medication, someone else might. We have to be very careful to keep all medication away from students who do not have a prescription for it. Please keep all allergy, cough, aspirin, etc. medication at home and only dispense it at home. If your child uses an inhaler for respiratory illness, he/she must have a doctor's note to have it at school and it must be kept at the office. If another child finds medication and tries it, he/she can become very ill. Our policy is designed to keep all students safe. Thank you for your understanding!
