If interested, please place them in an envelope marked "PTA Gift Cards" and turn them in to the main office of the school.

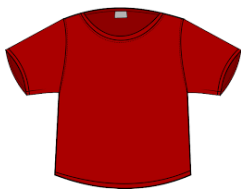

2023-2024 Student Council

Next school year, we would like to have a student council that represents interests of the students. Students will meet not less than monthly with the principal to discuss activities, ideas, and projects for classes. To begin that work right from the start of the school year, we will hold elections after spring break. Students must have no grade below a C – in any subject and get a recommendation from his/her homeroom teacher. 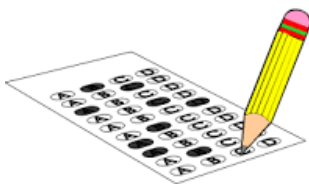
May 5 (In April, we will be on spring break the first Friday.)

2023-2024 St. Vivian Academic Calendar

On the following page you will find the upcoming year's academic calendar. This has been approved by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Please note that next year the school day will begin at 7:30A.M. and end at 2:25P.M. to build 15 more minutes into each day. We will begin and end the year on half days, releasing students at 11:00A.M. Please plan transportation for those 2 days. Students will return to the gym next year for morning care instead of the cafeteria. Morning care will be in the gym from 7:00-7:25A.M. and students will go to their homerooms at 7:25A.M. with homeroom beginning at 7:30A.M. *We will not offer breakfast next year since we are starting the academic day earlier.* This new start time will prevent downtime in the morning and allow everyone to begin learning earlier. We will send this calendar home again in May and in July.
