*Do you have gift cards you won't use; don't need; or wish to donate?*

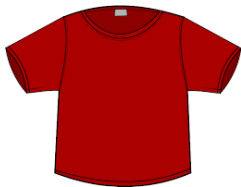
*Our St. Vivian PTA would be glad to take them off your hands!*

It is a child and workplace safe environment program specifically designed for Catholic entities. **Every person in a position which requires contact or interaction with youth or vulnerable adults must complete the SafeParish™ edition of Protecting Children from Sexual Abuse training session before they are permitted to work or volunteer within any of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati parishes, schools, or institutions.** No one under the age of 18 is permitted to complete the training.
