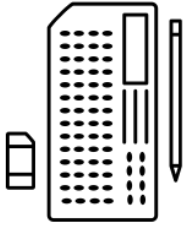

Used Uniform Items

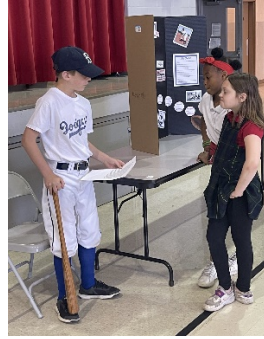
Have your children outgrown their uniforms?
