The Archdiocese of Cincinnati has adopted new standardized testing called I-Ready. I-Ready is a formative assessment that will be given 3 times each year to track the progress of students in reading and math. The diagnostic test will be given to all students in kindergarten through 8th grade in September, January, and May. Students will take the diagnostic and families will receive a report once testing is complete. The tests are given online at school and each child will then have a personalized learning path that he/she can access to practice skills. Once all classes have completed the diagnostic, reports will be sent to families.



ClassDojo

All teachers should have an account on Class Dojo. When you receive an invitation to join, please do so. This will allow teachers to communicate with you quickly with reminders, questions, and/or concerns. You can put the app on your cell phone and access it easily. As parents ourselves, we know that you want to know what is going on at school with your child(ren). This is an easy and effective way for that to happen. Rather than try to send home a lot of papers or keep track of points, teachers will contact you via Class Dojo. It is important that you stay tuned in to teachers' messages so that we can all support the students. If you haven't had an invitation to join your child(ren)'s Class Dojo, please reach out to the homeroom teacher(s).



Reminder : Cell Phones, Smart Watches, Earbuds, & Other Electronic Devices

We understand that students are connected via many devices and we understand that parents like to have that immediate access to them. However, NO devices may be on or used during school hours. When students arrive in the morning, all devices must be turned off and kept in backpacks. We cannot supervise who students are communicating with or what students are sharing with one another nor can we be responsible for devices. For a first offense, the device will be confiscated by the adult in charge and the student will have to remember to get the device at the end of the day. In a second offense the device will be sent to Mrs. Markham and a parent or legal guardian will have to get the device back from the office. If there is a third offense, we will require a parent/guardian conference and a possible \$50 fine may be assessed.



PE Uniform

In order to cut down on lost learning time, students may wear their PE clothes on their gym days. As shown by our models, Bryce and Jaina, students must wear the light gray or black PE t-shirts and black shorts with gym shoes. Kindergarten through 4th grade have PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays and 5th through 8th grades have PE on Mondays and Fridays. Preschool uniforms are optional this year as it is difficult to find such small sizes. During the cold weather months, students will be able to wear plain black sweatpants and a St. Vivian sweatshirt as part of the PE uniform. 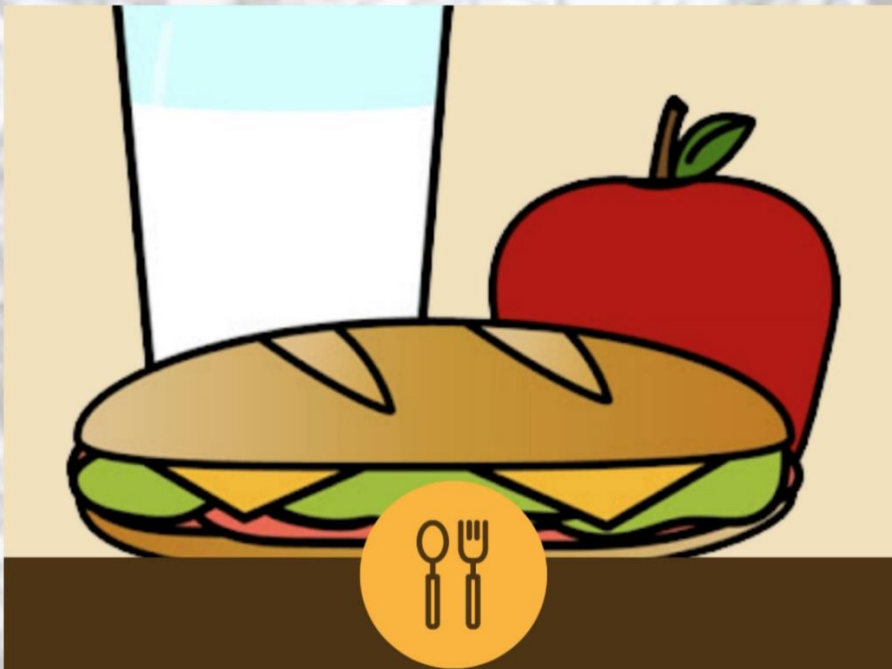

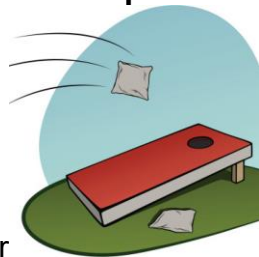
