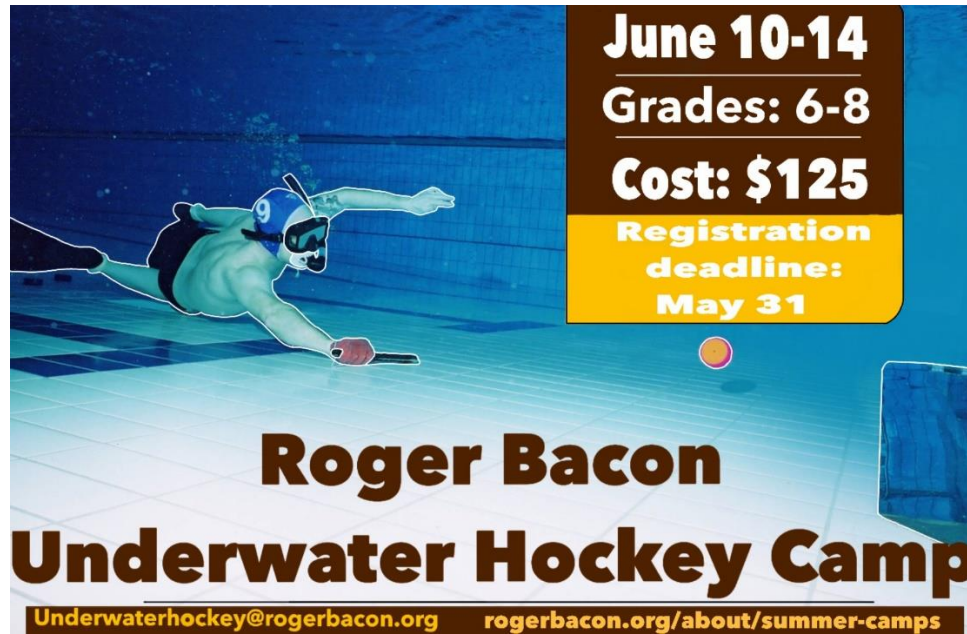
Rising 8th Grade Boys:
