That being said, I monitored each online classroom last week and I have spoken to the staff about expectations and tweaking the amount of assignments and when they are due. So, starting tomorrow, we will be following this schedule:

Teachers online :

9-11:30 am

6:30-8:00pm

Monday and Wednesday

Reading/Language Arts/Religion/Art/Computer

Assign on Monday Due on Wednesday/ assign Wednesday due on Friday.

Tuesday and Thursday:

Math/Science/Social Studies/Spanish/Music/PE

Assign Tuesday Due on Thursday; Assign Thursday due on Monday.

We would still have "free Fridays" to allow the work to be completed and caught up and allow teachers to prepare for the upcoming week and grade assignments.

It is my hope that by chunking assignments into days rather than giving assignments each day for every subject, it will be easier for students to complete and turn in their work when it is due.

Teachers will post more detailed information on their Google Classroom or Class Dojo.

We are all moving through uncertain, uncharted waters and will continue to re-evaluate and tweak lessons as we move forward.

The Governor just announced a stay at home order for all non essential personnel from Monday 11:59 pm until April 6th. I do look for him to close school for a longer period of time. I want everyone to be prepared that this is how school could be conducted for an extended period of time.
